EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

The Professional Certificate Program in CFP Certification Education meets the needs of students and mid-career professionals to prepare for the CFP® Certification Exam, one of the four cornerstones leading to certification as a Certified Financial Planner™— along with Experience, Education, and Ethics. The CFP® Board lists 89 integrated topics that are subject to testing for certification and that applicants must therefore master to be successful on the exam. Nevertheless, to meet the further Experience, Education, and Ethics requirements, students and professionals currently in the field must also consult and comply with the CFP® Board guidelines set forth at www.CFP.net/become.

Note: Completion of all 5 classes with a passing score of 70% or higher is necessary to qualify for the CFP Certification exam.

ENROLLMENT AND TUITION INFORMATION

Enrollment is open year-round; no application is required for enrollment.

1. Students who are ready to enroll in the Professional Certificate Program may visit www.onlinefinancialcertificates.com and click “Enroll.”
2. Students have the option to purchase a single course or all five courses. Once the course(s) have been selected, click “Enroll Today!”
3. Online access is only given for the courses in which you are enrolled. If you enroll in all five courses at one time, you will receive access to all courses.

TUITION

Students have the option to purchase an individual course or all five courses upon enrollment. Completion of all 5 classes with a passing score of 70% or higher is necessary to qualify for the CFP Certification exam.
